

Premium Hunting Opportunity

Carl Property Hunting Procedures

The Carl Property is located on Toppenish Creek along Pumphouse Road. Reservations to hunt this property will be made available to the public on weekends, Wednesdays and some holidays throughout the Public Hunting season of 2011-2012. Please call for a list of available dates. This 100 acre property contains high quality waterfowl hunting opportunities. Hunting on this property will be offered at a premium price in addition to the required Yakama Nation Hunting and Fishing Permit. Please remember that the Yakama Nation allows public hunting on this property as a privilege, not a right of the hunting public. We ask that those with reservations to hunt this property obey the rules, keep safety as their number one concern, and be courteous to others and to the neighboring landowners.

To reserve a full day hunt on this property, please follow the procedures outlined below.

How to reserve a hunt date: Hunting reservations can be made up to 2 weeks in advance of the hunting date. Reservations will be for the complete hunting date. The phone number for hunting reservations is (509) 865-5121 ext. 6307.

Number of hunters: 5 person maximum. The price per hunter is \$100. There will be a minimum charge of \$300 per day if the number of hunters is less than three. Payment must be made to the Yakama Nation Wildlife Program at least one week before the hunt date. A list of the names of the hunters in the group is required when you make your reservation. If there are any changes to the number of hunters hunting under a reservation, or if a reservation needs to be cancelled, it is the burden of the person holding the reservation to inform the Wildlife Program of the change at least one week prior to the hunt date. If no change is made and a hunter on the reservation list does not hunt the date, that hunter will still be charged as if he or she hunted the property.

Gate keys: A key to the entrance gate on Pumphouse Road will be provided to the hunter making the reservation. A map showing hunting blind locations will also be provided. The hunter making the reservation must pick up the key to the gate at the Yakama Nation's Wildlife Resource Management office prior to the hunt date. There will be no exceptions to this rule. After the hunt, the key must be immediately returned to the drop box located at the entrance gate to the property. Hunters who fail to return the key immediately will not be allowed to hunt the property again.

Harvest Reporting: An envelope with harvest information will be provided with the key. A report on the number of hunters and the number of birds taken per species will be required for each reservation.

Weather Contingencies: Certain weather conditions, such as very cold temperatures, may make the property un-huntable. Please call ahead to ensure that conditions are favorable to hunting on the day of your reservation.

Visitor Lodge: Please inquire to the availability of the visitor lodge. In 2011-12 it may be available for use during the hunting day. Overnight accommodations will not be available this year.
