THE YAKAMA NATION WILDLIFE RESOURCE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM IS CURRENTLY MONITORING FOR A BRAIN DISEASE IN DEER AND ELK KNOWN AS CHRONIC WASTING DISEASE OR CWD.

THIS DISEASE IS NOT PRESENTLY KNOWN TO OCCUR IN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON. TESTING FOR THE DISEASE ON THE RESERVATION IS A PRECAUTIONARY MEASURE AT THIS TIME.

Brain stem samples will be collected at the Mill Creek and Old Maid Guard Stations. Samples may also be collected at your place of residence by calling Dave Blodgett Jr. at 949-2257.

Heads should not be frozen and should be less than 48 hours old.
