SUMMARY SPORT FISHING REGULATIONS

YAKAMA RESERVATION

Except as noted, these regulations do not apply to enrolled members of the Yakama Nation. A current Yakama Nation Hunting & Fishing permit is required.

NOTE: released trout of legal size count toward daily catch limits, and the posession limit equals two catch limits.

EAST AREA:

Description:

The area bordered by the Yakima River, Ahtanum Creek, the Closed Area boundary, and the Yakama Reservation exterior boundary.

Special Regulations:

Charley's pond is open for juveniles only (under 13 years of age).

CLOSED WATERS:

Marion and Harrah Drains and their laterals, Satus, Logy and Dry Creeks are closed year-round (also restricted for tribal memebers under T-14-82). Elsewhere, within 400 feet downstream from a dam, fish ladder or other obstruction, or in rearing, holding or passage facilities, or when posted as closed waters.
