## JUNE 30, 2023 PUBLIC NOTICE OF WOLVES IN OR AROUND TRACT D

Be aware that there is a breeding pair of wolves hanging in or around the Tract D area. One of the wolves is GPS collared and is being closely tracked by Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife. Currently there are no reports that these wolves have preyed on livestock or pets in Tract D. Wolves have a strong aversion to humans and will avoid them. During the recreation area open period, there is a chance that people may see or hear the wolves, but more likely, the wolves will avoid the area and human interaction.
