
ABSOLUTELY NO BIKES ALLOWED ON ANY HUNTING PROPERTIES (no E-bike, pedal bike or motor bike)

- * CAMPING ON FEEL FREE TO HUNT LANDS IS NOT PERMITTED
- * DRIVING VEHICLES ON FEEL FREE TO HUNT LANDS IS NOT PERMITTED
- * HUNTER ORANGE IS REQUIRED FOR UPLAND GAME BIRD HUNTING.
- * NON-TOXIC SHOT IS REQUIRED FOR WATERFOWL HUNTING
- * HUNTING WITH RIFLES IS NOT PERMITTED - SHOTGUN ONLY
- * ASK FOR PERMISSION BEFORE HUNTING PRIVATE LAND OR TRIBAL LANDS.
- *DO NOT SHOOT NEAR LIVESTOCK OR RESIDENCES
- * LITTERING IS ILLEGAL - IF YOU PACK IT IN, PACK IT OUT
- *ALCOHOL IS PROHIBITED ON ALL YAKAMA NATION HUNTING AREAS
- *ENFORCEMENT WILL BE OUT CHECKING LICENSE AND BAG LIMITS PERIODICALLY.
- *CIVIL FINES WILL BE ENFORCED FOR ALL HUNTING VIOLATIONS.

Wild Turkey Hunting
Absolutely no fall/winter turkey hunting allowed. The Yakama Nation will be offering 10 wild turkey hunts in the spring of 2026. Special Spring turkey permits will be issued by raffle drawing. For more details see www.ynwildlife.org/turkeyhunting

Electronic callers may be used for Snow Geese ONLY Robo ducks are legal on reservation hunting with a fee added to permit. Everyone in the hunting party must have the Robo duck fee added to their permit.



This sign designates areas that have been set aside as resting places for wildlife and are not to be hunted.

**These regulations apply to public hunters only. Enrolled members of the Yakama Nation may hunt on any day, no reservation required They are encouraged to not hunt on Wed. & Sun.
